Food Bank of East Alabama

The mission of the Food Bank is to alleviate hunger; to provide an efficient, coordinated system for collecting and distributing food; to reduce food waste; and to increase public awareness regarding hunger and food security issues in East Central Alabama. We distribute 4.5 million pounds of food per year to over 190 feeding programs across East Central Alabama. Our partner agencies include emergency food pantries, shelters for the homeless, soup kitchens, special residential facilities, low-income day care providers, after school programs and shelters for abused women. Ninety-four cents of each donated dollar are put towards program services.

Los Angeles Regional Food Bank

The mission of the Los Angeles Regional Food Bank is to mobilize resources to fight hunger in our community. We source and acquire food and other products and distribute them to needy people through charitable agencies or directly through programs; conduct hunger education and awareness campaigns and advocate for public policies that alleviate hunger. Since 1973, the Los Angeles Regional Food Bank has distributed more than 1.2 billion pounds of food. With the help of 30,000 volunteers annually and an agency network of more than 600 partner agencies, we serve more than 300,000 people on a monthly basis. Ninety-seven percent of revenues go directly to programs.
